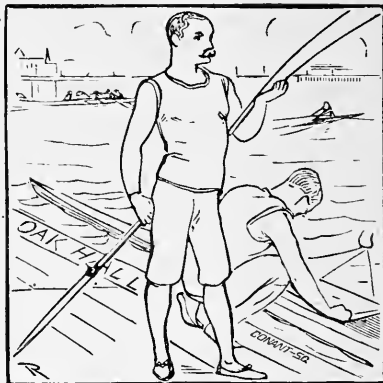

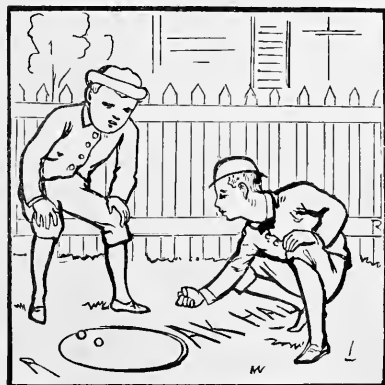

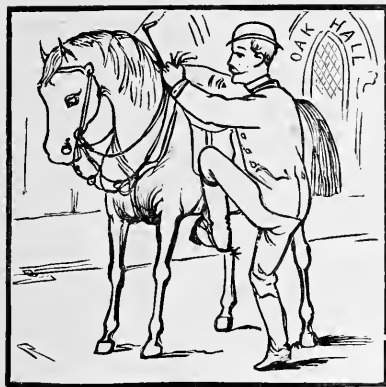

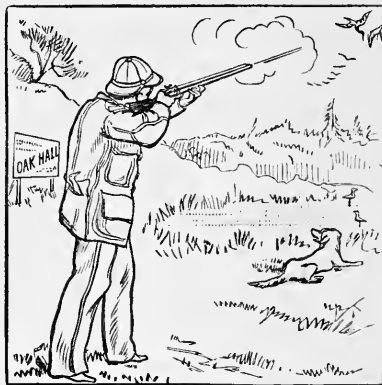


The father walks with his son. The day is cold. But their ulsters keep them warm. They wear fur caps.

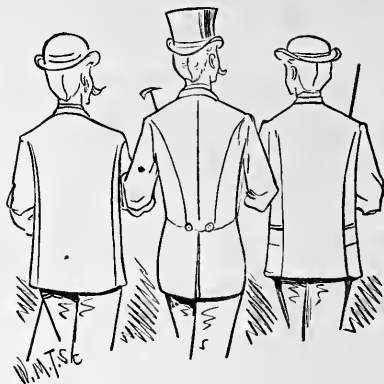
